Approval of regular meeting minutes of February 7, 2023

DRAFT MINUTES OF FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING Homewood-Flossmoor High School, 999 Kedzie Ave., Flossmoor, February 7, 2023

In attendance for all of the meeting were Ms. Jackson, Mr. Pauling, Mr. Anderson, Dr. Wakeley, Dr. Cook, Ms. Carla Erdey, Mr. Patterson and Mr. Richardson. DLA Architects, Mr. Ed Wright, Mr. Ryan Kelley and Ms. Heather Juhl were also in attendance.

Ms. Marilyn Thomas, HF Chronicle, was also present for all of the meeting. Ms. Larcocca, a member of the public, was also in attendance.

The meeting was called to order at 7:33 a.m.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u>. The November 1, 2022, Finance Committee minutes stand approved as presented.

Comments. No comments were received.

Construction Projects Updates

- Field House Lighting Project Mr. Patterson gave a brief update on the Field House lighting project. There has been a component delivery delay but he is anticipating starting the project the week of February 13th. Once all of the components are received it will be 4 weeks to completion. He will provide an additional update once all of the components are received.
- Science Addition/Renovation DLA Architects gave an extensive presentation on the project. Last August, the architects recommended to delay bidding the project due to unfavorable market conditions at that time that included market saturation, supply costs increase and labor costs which all have increased since Covid. The market conditions are showing some improvement and they believe the timing is good to move forward with the bidding process. At the August Finance Committee meeting, the committee approved applying for the Illinois Clean Energy Community Foundation Grant. The grant will provide funding for a Net Zero building. The one time grant would ensure up to \$2 million to cover the additional costs associated with the use of GeoThermal and other energy generating systems. Mr. Wright stated that energy costs of the building would be around \$84,500.00 energy cost offset annually per year based on the size of the addition. The life of a standard solar panel is about 20 years and the savings for energy costs will be just shy of \$2 million. The district has been accepted into

the pre-proposal phase of the grant application process. Mr. Wright noted that the district is on the short list of "1" to receive the grant. Dr. Wakeley added the award committee generally disapproves more than they approve. There has been a lot of lead-in work that has been done and the grant committee is very selective with the applicants. March is the proposal submission phase with June, 2023 as the start of construction. Mr. Kelley noted the \$2 million in grant money that is received goes directly to the district. The money that the district receives would cover the consulting. The ongoing cost of running that building would be zero. The consulting cost is a fixed cost and has already been factored into the district's budget. Mr. Kelley stated the next step is to go out to bid in April, accepting those bids back in early May for board approval. Construction would begin in June, 2023 with completion in June, 2024. Ms. Jackson suggested that DLA encourage minority vendors who may be interested in bidding this project. Mr. Wright stated that they are also looking to include culinary as an alternative to this project. Ms. Juhl reviewed the floor plans of the new science building and highlighted areas that include a new entry vestibule on the first floor. An outdoor space classroom. Internal grades that include stairs and an elevator. There is a central commons area and it is open to the college engineering space with green walls included throughout the building. There is also space to teach students about what goes into making a building net zero. Monitors will be mounted so students can see the energy usage of the building making it part of the learning experience. In addition, there is a second floor learning space. Mr. Wright added this building would benefit student wellness with its connection to nature with natural lighting, which has been shown to increase students' performance. There is also an open space area that the district can use for lectures and gatherings. Mr. Wright spoke on the budget that it is in line with what they presented to the committee previously with a projected total construction cost of \$17,665,000 -\$20,855,000. The committee agreed with moving forward with the bid process and presenting bids for the project in April.

Door Lock System

Mr. Richardson and Mr. Patterson provided an overview of ITR Systems Openpath, an exterior door locking system that uses mobile devices as credentials, requires no onsite servers and is managed via internet browser from any computer. The total cost includes the cost of equipment, installation, a five-year subscription plan, labor and material to install data cables at each location for a total cost of \$143,595.00. This project was not budgeted for the 2022-2023 school year, however, it is being recommended by the Director of Operation and Maintenance, the Director of Information Services and the Chief School Business Official to move forward with this as it will provide an additional

and necessary level of security to the building. The Finance Committee agreed with the recommendation to move forward with the purchase of the Openpath system.

Property Tax Relief Grant Program

Dr. Cook provided a historical overview of the Property Tax Relief Grant (PTRG) program that the district has participated in since FY 2019. As an example, the PTRG will provide an annual savings of approximately \$350.00 - \$425.00 on the homeowner's tax bill for an average home of \$250,000. Dr. Cook explained in 2018, 2019 and 2022, the district applied for and received the grant. The grant provides the district with additional state funds with a requirement to use the funds for one or two years to abate (reduce) its tax levy. The board has voted annually to provide additional property tax relief beyond the mandatory abatement requirement. Dr. Cook pointed out that the district is one of few that has abated back to the taxpayers the extra revenues from the grant as the majority of other districts do not. Applying for the FY23 PTRG, will generate an additional \$2,090,552 in tax abatements beginning in this 2022 levy year. The total taxes abated by the board through FY 2023 will total \$18,047,491.80 and includes the optional abatement that the board approved with a total cost of \$336,970.50 to the district. The PTRG is based on an average of student enrollment and the optional abatement through the PTRG that the board approves is based on Evidence Based Funding (EBF). Dr. Cook noted that the Illinois State Board of Education applies a very complicated formula for EBF and information on the EBF and the EBF Formula is available on the ISBE website. Dr. Cook will provide that information to the Committee. The recommendation to participate in the Property Relief Grant program will be on the February 21, 2023 board agenda for approval. Dr. Cook added that by participating in the program, the district is required to abate.

FY2022 Annual Financial Report Summary

Dr. Cook reported that the district has received an overall score of 3.80 out of 4, earning the highest possible rating of recognition from the Illinois State Board of Education which has been the only designation earned during Dr. Cook's tenure. He spoke on the five key indicators and noted the district receiving 4 out of 4. The five key indicators are as follows:

- Fund balance to revenue ratio 4 out of 4 (greater or equal to 25% 132.6%)
 [only looks at education, O&M, transportation, and working cash funds].
- Expenditure to Revenue Ratio 4 out of 4 (spending \$1.00 or less for every dollar received - 95 cents for every dollar received) [education, O&M, and transportation].
- Days cash on Hand 4 out of 4 (at least 180 days of cash on hand 494.71 days/16 month reserve) [education, O&M, transportation, and working cash.

- Percentage of Remaining Short-Term Borrowing Ability 4 out of 4 (greater than or equal to 75% debt margin remaining 100%).
- The last piece in the last 3 years received 3 out of 4. This year due to issuing new bonds Percentage of Remaining Long-Term Borrowing Ability - 2 out of 4 (greater than or equal to 75% debt margin remaining, we are at 41.29% remaining). The district is currently able to go out and borrow up to 42.9% and they are looking for a district to borrow at 72%.

Dr. Cook reiterated that the district still received the highest possible recognition that can be earned. He noted the score in 2012-2013 was also slightly down, 3.9, due to some of the same indicators that he described.

FY2022 Annual Investment Report Summary

Dr. Cook explained that the district is part of an investment pool of 20 school districts/school agencies that is managed by Township Treasurer Dr. Rob Grossi. The primary investment must meet short-term cash flow needs. Investments were mostly CDs, bank notes, and short-term taxable municipal bonds. The District earned \$526,616 in interest on investments during FY2022 (2021-2022 school year). This is a decrease of approximately 46% from FY2021 (2020-2021) where the District earned \$981,100.00 in interest on investments mainly due to delay in Cook County Tax Collection and Distribution. Instead of investing in 6 months, 1 year, and 3 year options, the Treasurer's Office ensured that cash was available to pay the districts' bills. Dr. Cook is anticipating seeing an increase in earnings at this time next year. Mr. Anderson would like to explore looking at making different investments outside of the pool allowing the district to make its own independent decisions. Mr. Anderson suggested continuing a conversation on future investments.

Legislative Updates

Dr. Cook stated that there currently no real new legislative updates except CPI All Urban as of December 31, 2022 was 6.5%. He also noted there has also been talk on the possibility of a short recession in June or by the end of the year, that is due in part with employment rates that are at an all time low. There has also been no indication of a property tax freeze or pension shift.

2023-2024 Budget Calendar

Overviewing the 2023-2024 budget calendar is a formality that Dr. Cook provides to the committee annually. Conversations with department chairs and administrators will begin in late May and department needs will be discussed. At that time, Dr. Cook will take a look at some possible potential savings. In August, Dr. Cook will provide information on what the budget will look like and in September the budget will be recommended to the board for approval. The District must then file with the Cook County Clerk within 30 days

of the adopted budget. There have been no changes to the timeline and it is consistent with previous years' timelines.

Adjournment. The meeting adjourned at 911 a.m.

Dear Dr. Cook;

As a follow up to our conversation concerning your transportation contract, I wanted to provide you with a written proposal for contract pricing for the 2023/2024 school year. Below I have listed some of the areas in our business that have affected our costs since we last discussed pricing.

LABOR

Due to Covid-19, the Nation-wide school bus driver shortage continues. We have seen some improvement but expect the shortage to remain for most of the 2022/2023 school year. Besides actively recruiting new employees, we have also been increasing wages substantially. This also helps us retain our existing employees. Wages were increased 5.3% for the start of the 2022/2023 school year and we are planning on a 15.0% increase for the 2023/2024 school year.

The mechanic shortage is also continuing. Mechanics are very hard to find/hire/train. We have had to raise wages substantially to attract more mechanics. We expect to increase their wages another 15% for next school year.

COST OF VEHICLES

We try to replace approximately 7-10% of our fleet each year. Deliveries of these vehicles has been delayed by supply chain issues, but we will be placing another order in hopes of delivery during the summer of 2023. New buses cost about \$125,000.00/each which is a 20% increase from last year.

INFLATION

Inflation has taken off and remains high today. All items C.P.I. for December was 6.5%. During the 2023 calendar year all items C.P.I. was 7.5 – 8.5%.

PARTS FOR BUSES

Due to the pandemic and supply chain issues, we have not replaced as many older buses as we would have liked. Therefore we are having to repair more buses. Parts are difficult to find. and if you can find them they are 20-25% more expensive than last year.

FUEL

Our fleet consists of diesel engines and gas engines. School buses are heavy, well constructed vehicles designed for the safety of its occupants. School buses also stop and go very often during their routes. Due to all of this we only get about 6 miles on a gallon of fuel. From October of 2021, fuel prices are up an average of 25%. We don't anticipate fuel prices coming down anytime soon.

INSURANCE

For the 2022/2023 school year we received a 9.0% increase of all risk insurance policies (liability, auto, workers comp., etc).

Based on all of the above, we are asking for a 10.0% increase for all price categories for 2023/2024. (see enclosed)

- Will continue to analyze the price increases with current CPI and market changes



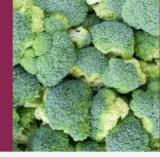
